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**Lecture Program**

**Christof Wiechert**



Christof Wiechert was a pupil at the Waldorf school in the Hague, Netherlands. After studying education and geography he began a career of 30 years teaching at the Waldorf school in the Hague. During this time he was co-founder of the Dutch State Waldorf Teacher Training Seminar. For many years he was a Council member in the Anthroposophical Society in the Netherlands. Together with Ate Koopmans he developed the "Art of Child Study" course. He has lectured in many countries.

Since September 1999 he has worked for the Pedagogical Section, from October 2001 to December 2010 as head of the Educational Department of the School of Spiritual Science at the Goetheanum in Dornach/Switzerland. He now continues to work for the School of Spiritual Science at the Goetheanum and on pedagogical and anthroposophical themes in different countries.

**Nana Göbel**



Nana Göbel was a student at Waldorfschool Pforzheim. From 1974-80 she studied Classical Archaeology, Egyptology and History. In 1976, Nana co-founded the Freunde der Erziehungskunst Rudolf Steiner, and is currently Managing Director and a Board Member. Nana is also involved in the International Youthwork at the Goetheanum, Dornach and at GLS Gemeinschaftsbank in Bochum.

Nana has been on the Boards of many organisations, including Gemeinnützige Treuhandstelle in Bochum, the Anthroposophical Society in NRW, the Board of the Anthroposophical Society in Berlin, the Anthroposophical Society in Germany and General Secretary of the Anthroposophical Society in Germany.

She was also a founding board member of the Board of the European Forum for Freedom in Education and "Zauberstäbchen, Gesellschaft für humanitäre Hilfe und Hilfe für Kinder in Südost - und Osteuropa e.V."

Nana is currently on the Board of IAO (Internationale Assoziation Osteuropa), and a Member of the Hague Circle (International Conference of Waldorf Steiner Schools).
